

# Entry and Stay Conditions for Incoming Travellers

Updated 26 November 2022; Ministry of Health; **with effect from 1 December 2022.**

## Changes from March 2022:

- Routine requirement for COVID-19 vaccination has been removed.
- Routine requirement for negative COVID-19 test has been removed.
